## THE APOSTLES CREED (said together)

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church\*, the Communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

\*The phrase "holy catholic Church" means the Church worldwide.

Leader: Lord, you are near to all who call on you. Hear us now as we lift up our needs to you.
