### Apostles Link Update

If you have logged into Apostles Link recently, you may have noticed that you can now see people's email addresses! Since we began using Apostles Link we have received a lot of feedback about not being able to see people's email addresses. Church Community Builder (the company that runs Apostles Link) has recently made some updates to their system and it is now an option to make email addresses visible. The *only* people who will be able to see your email address, and the only people's email addresses you will be able to see, are people who are part of one of your groups. This include ministry teams, community groups, and all of the Apostles members.

We made this change effective for everyone, but we also understand that not everyone may want their email address visible. While we do encourage you to keep this setting available on your account to foster communication amongst your group members, you are able to turn it off.
